SAINT OF THE WEEK – **EXAMPLES OF OUR FAITH Blessed Carlo Acutis**

Blessed Carlo Acutis (1991 –2006) was born in London, England and raised in Milan, Italy. From an early age, he displayed a remarkable talent for computer programming and a deep love for the Christ in the Eucharist. He loved sports,

particularly soccer, playing video games, graphic novels, and volunteering with those in need outside of his school hours.

Carlo's particular devotion to the Eucharist was inspired by St. Francis of Assisi and evident in that he always spent time in prayer before his parish's tabernacle either before or after every Mass he attended. He tried to go to Mass daily and he saw the Eucharist as a tangible manifestation of God's love.

With his tech-savvy skills, young Carlo spent four years creating a website that catalogued Eucharistic miracles from around the world. The purpose of his site was to increase awareness and appreciation for the Eucharist while also celebrating the worldwide Church. His hope for this project was to inspire those who visited the site to deepen their faith and develop a stronger relationship with Jesus.

Tragically, in 2006 when Carlo was just 15, his life was cut short when he succumbed to leukemia. Despite this, his story, and website, live on as a shining example of youthful holiness. Recognizing his extraordinary sanctity, the Church beatified Carlo on October 10, 2020, making him the first millennial to be beatified.

Carlo's beatification has gone on to spark a renewed interest in the Eucharist among some young people today. His story also serves as a reminder that holiness is attainable even amid modern challenges and that today's tools, like computers and the internet, can also be an avenue through which someone can serve the Kingdom of God. The rules for fasting before Communion are fairly straightforward, but there's a surprising amount of confusion regarding them. While the rules for fasting before Communion have changed over the centuries, the most recent change was over 50 years ago. Before then, a Catholic who wished to receive Holy Communion used to have to fast from midnight on.



The Current Rules for Fasting Before Communion

The current rules were introduced by Pope Paul VI on November 21, 1964, and are found in Canon 919 of the Code of Canon Law: A person who is to receive the Most Holy Eucharist is to abstain for at least one hour before holy communion from any food and drink, including chewing gum, except for only water and medicine. A priest who celebrates the Most Holy Eucharist two or three times on the same day can take something before the second or third celebration even if there is less than one hour between them.

St. Paul's has been under Construction/ Renovation for the past week, and it will continue through the month.


The Sanctuary and Sacristy have been tiled and the church proper will start having the carpet replaced.
